

Marking Criteria for ITEC Level 2 Diploma for Beauty Specialists Unit 10 – Make-Up

Candidates must be able to demonstrate the following:-

APPEARANCE – 5 MARKS (0.5 marks each)

1. Clean, ironed professional uniform.
2. Hair must be clean, neat and tied back/up if long and off the collar and face.
3. Nails must be short, clean, well manicured with no varnish and clean hands.
4. Clean, sensible full flat shoes, socks should be worn.
5. Females if wearing a skirt must have tights which are an appropriate colour for the uniform.
6. No jewellery- with the exception of a wedding band and 1 pair of small stud earrings (religious jewellery must be taped).
7. No body or breath odour.
8. No chewing gum or sucking sweets.
9. Underskirts/underwear should not be visible.
10. Skirts to the knee. Trousers cropped no higher than calf/ trousers not trailing on the floor.

CLIENT CARE – 5 MARKS (1 mark each)

1. Greeting and introduction of self to client.
2. Assisting client off the couch.
3. Explain the treatment procedure to the client.
4. Ensure client's comfort/ modesty throughout.
5. Maintain a positive and professional approach to client/colleagues throughout.

HYGIENE & STERILISATION – 10 MARKS (2 marks each)

1. Equipment should be wiped over with appropriate sanitiser before and after use.
2. Hands must be sanitised before, during and after treatment as appropriate.
3. Lids replaced on products and spatulas used to remove cream.
4. Cotton wool, tissues, paper roll and general waste to be disposed of hygienically and appropriately.
5. Salon/clinic sterilising equipment/cabinets used as appropriate and small equipment used, stored and sanitised as appropriate.

CLEANSE – 10 MARKS (2 marks each)

1. Candidate must select the correct cleanser for the skin type.
2. The cleansing routine should be performed twice.
3. Eye make-up and lipstick should be removed efficiently and thoroughly.
4. Cleanse should take no more than 5 minutes
5. The skin should be clean and free from cream/lotion, i.e. bottled and toned.

SKIN ANALYSIS – 10 MARKS (2.5 marks each)

1. Where possible inspection lamp should be used.
2. Candidate should be able to recognise any visible lesions/imperfections.
3. Candidate should be able to recognise all skin types/characteristics listed in the syllabus.
4. Candidate should recommend treatments/products that are suitable for the skin type.

MAKE-UP APPLICATION – 58 MARKS IN TOTAL TO INCLUDE FACE, EYES, POWDER, BLUSHER, LIPS (10 marks each) & OVERALL EFFECT (15 marks)

1. Correct use of pre-base (3 marks)
2. Face make-up – correctly and hygienically applied
3. Eye make-up – correctly and hygienically applied
4. Powder/Blusher – correctly and hygienically applied
5. Lip make-up – correctly and hygienically applied
6. Overall effect
