

Marking Criteria for ITEC Level 2 Diploma for Beauty Specialists Unit 9 – Skin Care & Eye Treatments

Candidates must be able to demonstrate the following:-

APPEARANCE – 5 MARKS (0.5 mark each)

1. Clean, ironed professional uniform
2. Hair must be clean, neat and tied back/up if long and off the collar and face
3. Nails must be short, clean, well manicured with no varnish and clean hands
4. Clean, sensible full flat shoes, socks should be worn
5. Females if wearing a skirt must have tights which are an appropriate colour for the uniform
6. No jewellery- with the exception of a wedding band and 1 pair of small stud earrings (religious jewellery must be taped)
7. No body or breath odour
8. No chewing gum or sucking sweets
9. Underskirts/underwear should not be visible
10. Skirts to the knee. Trousers cropped no higher than calf/ trousers not trailing on the floor

CLIENT CARE – 5 MARKS (1 mark each)

1. Greeting and introduction of self to client
2. Assisting client off the couch
3. Explain the treatment procedure to the client
4. Ensure client's comfort/ modesty throughout
5. Maintain a positive and professional approach to client/colleagues throughout

HYGIENE AND STERILISATION – 10 MARKS (2 marks each)

1. Equipment should be wiped over with appropriate sanitiser before and after use
2. Hands must be sanitised before, during and after treatment as appropriate
3. Lids replaced on products and spatulas used to remove cream
4. Cotton wool, tissues, paper roll and general waste to be disposed of hygienically and appropriately
5. Salon/clinic sterilising equipment/cabinets used as appropriate and small equipment used, stored and sanitised as appropriate

CLEANSE- 10 MARKS (2 marks each)

1. Candidate must select the correct cleanser for the skin type to remove full make-up
2. The cleansing routine should be performed twice
3. Eye make-up and lipstick should be removed efficiently and thoroughly
4. The skin should be toned, clean and free from cream/lotion
5. Cleanse/tone should be performed in commercially acceptable time

SKIN ANALYSIS – 10 MARKS (2 marks each)

1. The magnifying lamp must be used
2. Candidates should be able to recognise any skin imperfections/lesions visible and record them
3. Candidates should be able to recognise client's skin type/characteristics listed in the syllabus
4. Candidates should recommend treatments that are suitable for the skin type/characteristics
5. Candidates should be able to recommend suitable products for home care

LASH TINTING – 10 MARKS (2 marks each)

1. To be aware of contraindications
2. To ensure the client has had a patch test
3. To mix correct colour and consistency according to client's wishes and manufacturer's advice and ensure minimum wastage
4. To apply tint thoroughly and carefully
5. To remove tint efficiently and create darkened lashes

BROW SHAPE – 10 MARKS (2 marks each)

1. Candidates should discuss clients requirements
2. Candidates should measure the eyebrow
3. When performing treatment the skin must be stretched and gloves must be worn
4. Hairs should be removed quickly and efficiently and placed on a tissue or cotton wool
5. Therapists must check for client's comfort throughout and approval of the finished result

MASSAGE – 20 MARKS (2 marks each)

1. Appropriate medium is selected for the massage and applied professionally
2. The therapist demonstrates effleurage movements
3. The therapist demonstrates petrissage movements
4. The therapist demonstrates tapotement and vibration movements
5. The therapist demonstrates friction movements
6. The routine flows and contact is maintained throughout.
7. The routine demonstrates appropriate pressure for the client from area to area
8. The client's comfort is maintained throughout
9. The therapist must focus on client throughout
10. The therapist demonstrates good posture throughout

MASK – 10 MARKS (2 marks each)

1. To prepare the area
2. To mix and apply an appropriate clay recipe for the skin type and demonstrate application of commercial mask additionally
3. To apply all products evenly, efficiently and minimising waste
4. To understand the effects of the ingredients in the products used and their contraindications
5. To remove efficiently and comfortably for the client

HOME CARE ADVICE – 10 MARKS (2 marks each)

1. Candidate to conclude the treatment in an appropriate way.
2. Recommendation made for follow-on appointment.
3. Recommendations made for immediate after care.
4. Recommendations made for home care advice.
5. Inform the client of the short term effects of the treatment.

SAMPLE ORAL QUESTIONS

1. Describe the client's skin type
2. What is vitiligo?
3. What is the cause of vitiligo?
4. What sort of mask would be suitable for this skin type – why?
5. Describe the contraindications to this treatment
6. What after care advice would you give to the client?
